Dear Senator Atkins,

I posted on 9/18/2019 to my study of Assembly Bill 1404 (2013), I have a First Amendment right “to petition the Government for a redress of grievances,” and to be informed as to the results of that petition. As such, I wish to know what your top priorities for next year’s (2020) legislative session will be, and if these priorities include fixing the botched repeal-and-replace of Section 841 of the California Civil Code (enacted *via* AB 1404). In other words,

will you commit to fixing California’s flawed “Good Neighbor Fence Act of 2013” in 2020 — yes? or no?

I believe I have a constitutional right to be advised if your legislative priorities for 2020 deviate significantly from mine, so that I can make informed choices, as a citizen and voter, in upcoming elections, as can others who are closely following this issue. My Web-based petition has a growing audience, reaching well beyond your state and local constituencies, so there is widespread interest in your decision.
